The Alabama Thoroughbred Breeders Racing Association will hold a stallion auction fund raising event. It will be held online at www.Starquine.com January 8th – 15th, 2012. This event is to raise monies towards The Alabama Stallion Stakes Series. The first race was a 40,000 stakes race named The Camilla run in 2011 at Evangeline Downs. It will be run each year; however the purse is based on available funds, this coming year it will be at \$25,000 – 40,000 to be determined. This is why your donations are so important, as they go directly back into our purses. There will be additional races added as fund raisers and additional donations are made over the years. All race times and dates will be determined at a later date; however, the location will be at Evangeline Downs in Louisiana.

The Stallion Stakes series will be open for all Jockey Club registered stallion owners to participate. Stallions that stand outside Alabama can participate by donation of one stallion season. Stallions that are resident to Alabama can participate by paying a \$100.00 nomination fee or donating a stallion season. Once the season is donated, or the stallion is nominated, all of said stallions' progeny will be eligible from that year's resulting foal crop. Each foal from the approved stallion shall pay additional fees for nomination. The foal nominations will be \$25.00 for the weanling year, \$100.00 for the yearling year, \$200.00 for the two year old year a \$150.00 entry fee and a \$150.00 starter fee to complete the foal's eligibility requirement for the stakes series.

All stallion season donations are tax deductible under the non-profit donation status of The Alabama Thoroughbred Breeders Racing Association.
